Status of Taskings:

Tasking 2015-02 3007 Revision. Hicks  
Rough draft out to review team. Review team Telecon 12/10/2015. Clean up rough draft over the holiday break. Next draft out early 2016. Review proceeding "OK." Note that Hicks will be changing positions at the end of DEC.

Tasking 2015-03 AA HNDBK. McLaughlin/Hicks  
Out to CSSG for review and comments by 18DEC15. Needs to be issued early January for DOE.

Action: Erickson to send reminder.

Tasking 2015-05 WTP Wilson  
Tasking has been drafted, awaiting info (dates) from ORP to proceed. Waiting for documents from Battelle, expected early 2016. Anticipate one month document review. Guessing late FEB to mid-MAR on-site review. Facility will not be operating in the near term. Thus, no impact on operations.

STD-3009/CFR 830 Nuclear Safety overload on NCS Hayes/Hicks  
Strawman developed, but no further progress. Need to put meat on the bones without coming across as whining.

Action: Hayes/Hicks communicate to CSSG what has been identified, and proposed attack plan.

Review of Hands-On Class Hopper/Trumble/Kimball/Brady-Raap  
Need to draft the tasking. Hopper to develop expectation table based on previous CSSG positions. Wilson audited last class, will provide documentation to Trumble. Hopper to provide tasking wording to Hayes.

Action: Hayes draft the tasking. Wilson provide documentation to Trumble. Hopper to provide tasking wording to Hayes.

DOE-STD-1158 Revision

Little done on 1158. Erickson will support. Others solicited for support. New LOIs may be necessary.

Action: Erickson identify when CSSG may perform review and draft tasking accordingly.

New Tasking

All NCSP proposals will be provided to the CSSG for review to prioritize with a focus on rebaseline of the program. Data will be made available early FEB16 to support Face-to-Face meeting at the Technical Program Review (TPR) in MAR16. CSSG input will be required ~ 2 weeks post TPR. Determine if more than one day will be needed to meet at the TPR.

Action: Erickson determine if more than one meeting day is required during TPR.

Other

NCSP Manager Succession Planning:

Angela Chambers is the current selection to become the NCSP Manager upon McKamy's retirement. She has chaired the Nuclear Safety R&D committee. Several years before McKamy may retire.

Validation:

McKamy has asked the CSSG to think about validation across the complex.
