Notes from: Periodic CSSG Telecon

Agenda:

- Status of 3007 revision (and revision of tasking) – Hicks
BW – Telecon, assigned different portions. Drafts of sections are ‘coming in.’
Controversy due to DOE Fed version vs other versions being addressed: Working toward the middle.
- Another item: STD-1158 is being revised. Larry Berg has the lead. Is any CSSG member interested in being a part of the process? (We will all review a draft at some point.)
Action DE: Send message to CSSG regarding participation.
- Review of actions from the F-to-F last month (based on the notes) – Hayes
 - Action DE: Ensure something in transmittal letter indicating CSSG is interested in responses to recommendations and observations. May need to consider how this should be implemented. Included with Tasking 16-01Class Review transmittal. Still need to consider for future Taskings.
 - **Action DE: Check with JM re: CSSG review of Managers course.**
DE – Have not yet communicated with McKamy
FT – could be performed by review of slides by some of those involved in the two-week review. Also wait until after had a chance to digest current review actions.
 - Action CSSG: Should the CSSG develop a white paper on ‘Trivial Risk’ and CAAS evaluation?
Needs full CSSG discussion
 - **Action JH: Review/revise 3007 tasking based on feedback and recognition of need for new dates.**

 - **Action JH: Crit Incredibility - Justification vs potential impact on cost: Include in 3007 revision/discussion**

 - Action DE: Revise Charter and Work Instructions to incorporate ideas and forward to CSSG for review.
Action DE: Will try to get something out in next week or so.
 - Action KK: Management of criticality accident alarm systems

KK: Not yet begun due to other priorities. Distribute something in the next few weeks.

- Action DKH/JH: STD-3009/CFR 830 Nuclear Safety overload on NCS:
DKH: No effort, yet. Nothing concrete yet identified.
- Action Trumble/McLaughlin: Develop Tasking: CSSG White paper on what are the real effects of a Criticality Accident?
FT: Thought about it, TPM also provided some thoughts. However, due to LANL accounting is on 'CSSG hiatus.'
- Action DE: Recommend to the NCSP Management Team (via proposal feedback) that before significant additional effort is expended on adding additional S/U capability that the MCNP and SCALE developers develop some 'sales literature' regarding what the capabilities are (based on current, or very near term releases), what benefits/limitations they can provide to the CS practitioner. This can start by educating the CSSG to help identify how available AM code maintenance/enhancement funding should be focused.
DE: Adding something to the Proposal Review transmittal. Will also look at T&E review.
- Next F-t-F meeting?
Will discuss during future telecom.

- Status of WTP review – Wilson
BW: Some files have been sent. Specific time frame is still TBD. Non-coprecipitated CSER was a 'biggie' from prior review and has been provided.
