2016-04: Natural Phenomena and Extreme Events

DGE: Will send out for vote.

2016-05: Regulatory Impediments
Completed, awaiting status on UPF clearance concern prior to issue?
AC: Need to determine path forward.

NPH Handbook (Heinrichs)
Did we see it pre RevCom? It is now in RevCom.
TPM: Performed a review earlier, didn't see word 'criticality'. Section 2.3.3.1 – discusses severity of consequences from SSC failures (only?). So no likely release by failure itself, need to have a follow-on criticality.
DPH: Read document and offending material has been removed.
DGE: Will send notice to CSSG for their review.

10 CFR 830
DOE provided significant basis for revision. Did not include CS as a driver, but that will not preclude it from being considered.
CSSG should develop a position in advance of revision as able.
DPH: Motion to withdraw CS from 830. Opportunity to revisit 1027.
DKH: Will draft a Tasking to support revision when it comes up.

AA Handbook – feed back provided.
DOE-STD-1027 – looks like we are stuck until 10 CFR 830 is revised.
2017-03: 3007 Comment Resolution – This was completed and resolution(s) put into RevCom. Do not know next step.
