DOE O 420.1C Ch. 2

The latest change notice has been approved/released (July 26, 2018). Only identified minimal change/impact for criticality safety. Introduces DOE-STD-3007-2017 and has a new 'date of this standard' so several more recent ANS-8 Standards revisions are now applicable.

Potential future CSSG involvement

Sometime in FY19 it is expected that the CSSG will be requested to weigh in on a 'strategy' type approach, or similar, for concluding the Portsmouth X-333 facility can be determined to be criticality incredible. This new strategy will be a departure from the apparent method used at the K-25 facility at Oak Ridge. The expectation is that the ANS-8.1 requirement to "determine that the entire process will be subcritical under normal and *credible abnormal* conditions" (italics added) will be utilized more directly.
