Previous items update:

Items for discussion:

- Bunde Discuss his new role in EM 3.111
 - Kermit will work with Bob Wilson soon.
 - Did not describe what he will be doing.
 - Looking for CSEs and PDDs not sure who from DOE or NNSA
 - Will be transition in next 2 or 4 weeks
 - Unknown who will be backfill at INEL
- Bunde Revisit CS Specialist Training for DOE-STD-1173-2009
 - Because of the need to train someone for his position when he leaves, he wanted to review the CS training document that Cris Eberle sent to attendees.
 - Kermit requested input from attendees.
 - The current standard is well out of date and references standards that are not defunct or been updated.
 - Current standard says federal employee will write a criticality safety evaluation, but this is not likely to happen. This seems to be covered in training per attendees. This has also been covered by attending a class where a CSE was prepared.
 - There was a lengthy discussion on whether oversight meant you need to have the same qualifications as the M&O or not the consensus was no.
 - If the standard needs to be changed, find out who owns it and talk to them.
 - Kermit will speak with Angela Chambers about revising it.
 - There was an effort in June 2020 that died due to being overtaken by COV and retirements at the NTC.
 - The update in June 2020 was to meet the new requirements for MPAs similar to the NSS qual standard.
 - Cris asked about those who have qualified in last 5 years what have been the difficulties such as getting funding for travel, response was that the technical part was not difficult.
