ROUNDTABLE

Staff turnover one of the main issues we as a community are discussing and dealing with – Percher Haye – difficult for CSSG to leverage ourselves into Operations

WILSON – chage of mission is also a topic of concern – going from mission to D&D or going from R&D to production FITZ – is this an impact to disciplined operations and does this impact NCS evaluation assumptions?

WILSON – RFP example – letter to regulator stating NCS was in trouble is another possibility.
