Discussion:

David Heinrichs provided a summary of the EFCOG NCS COP Meeting held in August in Oak Ridge.

- ANSI/ANS-8.3, the new version is causing lots of stir in the community; lots of negative feedback
- Presentation by PNNL on sum of fractions while not new was well received
- From Brenda Hawks, Radiological Facility is not the same as Less than Hazard Category 3 Facility
- Timeline for 420.1D has become unclear (moved to the right from original want date)

Angela added that EM and Office of Science are not ready for a revision of DOE-STD-3007; areas for the writing group to possibly consider are the NPH language (depending on what happens to 420.1D) and the DSA Interface section.

David Heinrichs brought up a request from Michael Fendler from DOE-SRS (he is a subcontractor to the field office) to have the CSSG review the recently completed CAAS Needs Assessment for the Pit Production Facility. Members agreed it seemed reasonable for us to weigh in. Angela will reach out to Field Office (Gary Lee) to see if a more formal request is in the offing and a draft tasking will be put together after that assuming it is a yes.

FY End is upon us be on the look out for summary in accordance with the charter.

The next CSSG Meeting will be face to face in Orlando in conjunction with the ANS meeting. It will be on Thursday, 11/21/2024 from 8:00 to 1:00. A specific location will be announced before the meeting.

ROUND TABLE TOPICS

- Is there something the CSSG could be doing or should be doing with regards to the Y-12 bucket incident and trying to make lessons learned more broadly available? Jen Alwin allowed as how she is trying to promulgate lessons learned at LANL but might have better luck if it was coming from CSSG or Y-12 (as an example).
- Mike Zerkle asked if there was a way for NNSA/DOE sites to gang together to try and get NDA equipment built without the modern bells and whistles such as WIFI and Bluetooth. It was mentioned to bring it up at EFCOG and see if traction could be gained.
