- (2) The latest version of DOE-STD-1189 is in RevCom – everyone is encouraged to go review it. Note that it still refers to the old version of DOE-STD-3007.
- (3) The next virtual meeting of the CSSG will be via TEAMS on February 20th. The next Face to Face meeting of the CSSG is being planned for June 19th in conjunction with the ANS Meeting in Chicago.
- (4) Please turn in your financials to D. Hayes ASAP as they are due for Q1 reporting.
- (5) In regards to tasking report for 2024-02, Hayes would like to re-work the response to be more review and comment format and less of how to do needs analysis. Also, need to incorporate DOE-STD-1189 into the tasking report as it would seem to require CAAS at this stage of design. The tasking team seems to allude to this by recommending that the facility be wired everywhere for CAAS (even in areas where CAAS is determined to not be needed).

There was significant around the table discussion of the need for CAAS, whether or not 1189 required it, and other topics. In the end it was decided that the report could be reworked into a product that more of a majority of the CSSG could support.

J. Morman agreed to take a stab at reworking the report and having it back to the tasking team for review by the end of the following business week (January 17th) and back to the broader CSSG the week after that (January 24th).

CSSG comments due back to Jim by first week of February (02/07). D. Hayes agreed to set up a TEAMS call for the CSSG that same week to discuss comments and path forward. Doug and Catherine have the hands-on course that week and will have limited availability but will send a note with times they can meet after this meeting.

- (6) Around the Table: D. Ericksson asked if we needed a DAF review visit in the near term as it has been some time since the CSSG formally visited. D. Hayes proposed that we could do it in conjunction with the Budget Execution Meeting in July.
- (7) Around the Table: Heinrichs noted that the next Community of Practices Meeting will be held in conjunction with the upcoming EFCOG meeting in February.
