- (1) Kevin Reynolds and Jen Alwin provided a brief summary of the recently held Budget Execution Meeting. It was a virtual meeting held July 29th and 30th. Overall the shortfall of requests to money received in the requests seems small. Balance was achieved by reducing some tasks in the approved task list by \$1k each. There was talk of having a formal proposal review next year but details were few and more discussion is presumed on that topic.
- (2) The next Face to Face meeting of the CSSG will be September 18th in the afternoon (noon to five pm timeframe) at the conclusion of the NCS Topical meeting in Austin.
- (3) David Erickson asked if there was an update on DOE O 420.1D or DOE-STD-3007 work. It was noted that Kevin Kimball is working 3007 but no further details were available. It was noted that 420.1D seems to be hung up with no clear time frame for issuance. There is talk of a Change Notice to 420.1C being tossed about but no one is sure if that will come to pass either. Pat Moss noted that he thought it was Fire Protection issues that were holding 420.1D up not NCS.
- (4) The TPR will be held 12/2 through 12/5 in Knoxville (downtown not at ORNL).
- (5) Chris Eberle had no formal CSCT update beyond the already discussed update to 420.1D.
- (6) Mike Zerkle gave a brief NDAG update from the BEM perspective. He noted that the work to provide moderator physics guidance to Y-12 was top of list for the upcoming year.
- (7) There was brief discussion regarding DOE EA and assessments of NCS and whether or not they were bringing value to the complex. It was noted that further discussion may be warranted at the September meeting with more CSSG involvement to come. Maybe.
